

Notice of the Customs Tariff Commission of the State Council Regarding the Tariff Execution Plan 2010

(No. 28 [2009] of the Customs Tariff Commission)

General Administration of Customs,

The Tariff Execution Plan 2010, which has already been deliberated and adopted at the 5th plenary meeting of the Customs Tariff Commission of the State Council and has been approved by the State Council, shall be executed as of January 1, 2010.

Tariff Execution Plan 2010

1. Adjustment of import tariff

- a. We shall make following import tariff adjustments in line with the commitments of tariff reduction we made on the entrance of WTO:
 - 1) Reduce the Most-favored-nation Rate of Duty on 5 items, such as polyester cloth. Adjust the most-favored nation duty rate for wet blue at 6%.
 - 2) 9 partial-taxed IT products shall remain current tariff rate and under customs review;
 - 3) 1% interim quota rate shall be applied to fertilizer of urea, compound fertilizer and Diammonium Phosphate;
 - 4) Specific tariffs and mixed duties shall be applied to 55 items, like frozen chicken, tax rates remain unchanged;
- b. Contacted tariff rates shall be applied to goods from countries and regions under the specific favorable trade and tariff agreements signed between China and other countries and regions.
 - 1) 1767 items of goods from South Korea, India, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh and Laos shall remain tariff rates of AP-Trade Agreement;
 - 2) The tariff rate of part of the commodities from Brunei, Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore, Thailand, Philippines, Vietnam, Laos,

Cambodia and Burma shall remain unchanged according to the AFTA with China;

- 3) 7029 commodities originated from Chile shall continue the tariff rates under the FTA between Chile and China;
 - 4) 6240 commodities originated from Pakistan shall continue the tariff rate under the FTA between Pakistan and China;
 - 5) 7040 commodities originated from New Zealand shall continue the tariff rate under the FTA between New Zealand and China;
 - 6) 2753 commodities originated from Singapore shall continue the tariff rate under the FTA between Singapore and China;
 - 7) 1587 commodities originated from Hong Kong shall apply free tariff rate;
 - 8) 1209 commodities originated from Macau shall apply free tariff rate;
- c. Preferential tariff shall be applied to the commodities from 41 least developed countries identified by the UN. These countries include 4 from Southeast Asia, 31 from Africa, and 6 from other areas.
- d. General tariff rate shall remain unchanged.

2. Adjustment of Export Tariff

- a. The export tariff rate remains unchanged;
- b. Special export tariff shall be applied to some fertilizers, interim tariff remains applicable to some of goods like eels ;
